Quilt Entry Guidelines

The Mt Pulaski Courthouse Foundation is sponsoring a Quilt Show on Friday Sept. 11 and Saturday Sept. 12 during Mt. Pulaski's 2015 Fall Festival.

Antique and new quilts of all sizes will be accepted for exhibition at the Mt. Pulaski Courthouse. If you wish to exhibit your quilt (s) in the show, please send a completed Quilt Exhibit Entry form for each quilt you want to display to Ms. Tena Stoudt before August 15, 2015. This will allow time to prepare show information and organize displays before the delivery of the quilts. Please bring different quilts than you brought in 2012 if possible.

Actual quilts should be delivered to the Mt Pulaski Courthouse on Wednesday, September 9 between 12 and 6 p.m. To contact the Courthouse call 792-3919.

- 1) Each quilt loaned should have an identification label sewn or safety pinned to the lower back right hand corner. Include the exhibitor's name, address, phone number and quilt pattern. Include the owner's name if different from the exhibitor's.
- 2) Place each quilt to be submitted in a pillow case or other cloth bag with the same information on the bag as on the quilt. Each quilt must be in a separate bag.
- 3) A SEPARATE entry form must be completed for each quilt to be exhibited. They must be turned in to Ms. Tena Stoudt by August 15.
- 4) All quilts will be ready to be picked up at the Mt. Pulaski Courthouse at the end of the Saturday viewing session or on Sunday, Sept.13, between 2 p.m. and 3p.m.
- 5) We will invite visitors at the show to vote for their favorite quilt. Winners of that voting will receive first, second and third cash prizes.
- 6) We will take the best possible care of your precious quilts. There will be Courthouse Guides, Quilt Committee members, and friends of the Courthouse at the Courthouse during the entire time the quilt show is in progress. HOWEVER, we cannot be responsible for the value of any quilt. If this is a problem, please have your quilt covered by your personal insurance.
- 7) Submit your entry forms as soon as possible. You will receive a claim form for each quilt when you bring your quilt to the Mt. Pulaski Courthouse. YOU MUST bring the claim form to claim your quilt at the end of the show.
